

Biography of Isiah A. Williams:

Anointed, Radical, Fresh, Innovative and Called for this generation are some of the words often used to describe Isiah. In 2009 God challenged him to “dare to be different” in his methods of preaching the gospel, by simply being himself and meeting people “where they are”.

Isiah is an ordained pastor with a global mission to Shift Hearts and Change Lives through an unconventional delivery of the Word of God. He believes that the body of Christ should be empowered in every area of life. His preaching and teaching focuses on shifting the hearts and minds of believers spiritually, developing them educationally, exposing them culturally, sharpening them professionally and strengthening them relationally. His main goal is to tear down the barriers of RELIGION and encourage a true and real RELATIONSHIP with Christ Jesus and people.

At the age of 17 he was ordained as a minister under the Church of God In Christ and at 18 was ordained as an Elder and in 2012 he and his wife were ordained as pastors. Since his ordination he has continued to be a student of the gospel and is adamant about sharing the knowledge he attains regarding God and religion with people of all walks of life.

At the age of 3, Isiah’s father was incarcerated and was released in November of 2009. After 26 years of being a product a single parent household, he was threatened by gangs, and enticed by drugs and alcohol. Somehow Isiah’s mother exclaims that he got in to very little trouble. Suffering from a learning disability caught to late, Isiah silently struggled academically, which caused him to fail the 11th grade. Overcoming this disability and his fear he later obtained a GED certificate he went on to further his education and trade skills. He now uses his testimony of triumph to encourage young people to overcome their fears and inadequacies. He prays that he is a tool to help change young people’s perception of school and church.

He is the proud husband of 12 years to gospel recording artist Jai and a devoted father to his precious 11-year-old little girl, Taylor Alyssa.

He is currently serving as Interim Youth Pastor for the St. Louis Dream Center of Joyce Meyer Ministries.
